Áine Hyland

Dr Áine Hyland is a former Professor of Education in University College Cork. She was a founder member of the Dalkey School Project, as well as being a former chairperson of Educate Together.

Micheal Johnston was the first Chairperson of the Dalkey School Project and also the first Chairperson of Educate Together. He is currently the chairperson of the Board of Management of Newpark Comprehensive School.
