

3. Demographic details

The decision to announce a new school in this school planning area was on the basis of the demographic exercises carried out in 2018 as set out below.

The school planning area is served by four providers at post-primary level. Demographic analysis shows that the average actual intake pattern¹ in the last two years was 91%. The actual intake pattern for 2018/19 is 110%. The total enrolment in the school planning area in the 2018/19 school year was **2,332** pupils.

The estimated peak year is 2025 with enrolments of 2,364. Assuming a continuation of the three year average enrolment intake pattern of 91%, it is estimated that there will be a need for an additional 445 places between 2017 and 2025 with a subsequent projected reduction of 224 places over the peak year by 2029.

The demographic exercises for this school planning area identified the following net requirement taking into account demographic demand, additional places required as a result of significant additional residential development (including any development arising from the Local Infrastructure Housing Activation Fund – LIHAF) and the current and planned capacity increases in existing post-primary schools in the area:



Following a demographic exercise on this area, the Department was satisfied that the net requirement of 687 post-primary places in the Goatstown_Stillorgan DLR school planning area could not be accommodated in existing schools or through expansion of existing schools.

¹ **Average Actual Intake Pattern:** if all children resident or attend primary school in the relevant school planning area attended post-primary school in that school planning area, the intake pattern would be 100%. If the intake pattern is less than 100%, it would suggest that some children are travelling to school outside the school planning area. If the intake pattern is greater than 100%, it would suggest that a number of children are travelling into schools in the school planning area from other school planning areas. The average intake pattern over a number of years allows the Department to project the likely demand over the coming years assuming a continuation of the same pattern.

4.2 Language

4.2.1 Existing Provision

(i) Gaelscoileanna (Primary Level)

The following are the details of the Irish–medium gaelscoileanna located within the school planning area, and in the adjoining school planning areas.

A) Within the school planning area

There are currently no gaelscoileanna located in the school planning area. Gaelscoil na Fuinseoige was established in 2016 to serve this area and is located just outside this school planning area, in the adjacent Ballinteer Stepaside DLR school planning area.

The level of parental preferences for Irish-medium instruction is low (22 or 10.84% of first preferences) compared with 175 (86.21%) of preferences for English-medium while 6 (or 2.96%) of parents did not specify a preference in relation to language.

There is no Gaelscoil in the Goatstown_Stillorgan school planning area. Gaelscoil na Fuinseoige was established in 2016 to serve this school planning area and is located just outside the school planning area in the adjacent Ballinteer_Stepaside_DLR school planning area. The nearest Gaelcholáiste, Gaelcholáiste an Phiarsaigh, is located circa. 2km from this gaelscoil. There are three gaelcholáistí in the adjoining school planning areas.

In 2018/2019 there were 279 pupils in sixth class in total in the eight Gaelscoileanna located in the adjoining school planning areas. Of these gaelscoileanna, six are located closer to an existing Gaelcholáiste than they are to the future location of the new school. The remaining two gaelscoileanna are located less than 3.4km from their nearest gaelcholáiste.

An Foras Pátrúnachta is the only applicant patron to propose an Irish-medium school while all of the other applicant patrons proposed English-medium but indicated their willingness to offer an Irish-medium school if demand exists for same. All applicants have confirmed they are willing to open an Aonad should the demand require it.

5. Conclusions

- All patrons have confirmed that they will satisfy the requirements as set out by the Department for the patronage of new schools.
- All the models would increase diversity in the area by providing multi-denominational provision in the area.
- > Educate Together received the highest number of valid first preference votes i.e. 151.
- The level of parental preferences for Irish-medium instruction was 22 of 203 valid first preferences (10.84%) compared with 175 of 203 valid first preferences (86.21%) for English-medium instruction. It is noted that three gaelcholáistí are located less than 3km from the future location of the new school, of which two have a denominational ethos and one has a multi-denominational ethos. It is expected that these schools have sufficient school places to accommodate this level of demand.
- ➤ Based on the results of the parental preferences and broader analysis, including the extent of diversity currently available in this and the adjoining school planning areas, the analysis indicates that the patronage of the new post-primary school for the Goatstown_Stillorgan DLR school planning area should be awarded to Educate Together to provide a multi-denominational Voluntary Secondary School with English as the language of instruction.
