TENDER FOR DEVELOPMENT OF ONLINE TEACHER RESOURCE GUIDE

Suitably qualified and experienced individuals and/or teams are invited to submit a tender outlining their proposal **to design and develop an online resource for teachers based on an existing resource guide (PDF format currently), for example an online repository system; online toolkit or similar which can be used by teachers to support them in teaching the Educate Together Senior Cycle Ethical Education Curriculum. The guide has already been developed, the task here is to develop an accessible online format to support its use by teachers through our online learning platform on Moodle.**

Background

Educate Together comprises a growing network of 119 schools in Ireland (96 primary and 23 second-level schools). In addition to the national curriculum, Educate Together schools teach Ethical Education. The aim of Ethical Education is to extend and hone students' ability to explore, question, understand and reflect critically on their own values, beliefs, worldviews and those of others, and to develop their skills to communicate effectively and respectfully and act ethically.

The Ethical Education Curriculums at primary and second-level are an important element of fulfilling the Educate Together Charter which commits to the establishment of schools which are:

- **Equality-based**, i.e., all children having equal rights of access to the school, and children of all social, cultural and religious backgrounds being equally respected,
- **Co-educational** and committed to encouraging all children to explore their full range of abilities and opportunities,
- **Learner-Centred** in their approach to education,
- **Democratically run** with active participation by parents in the daily life of the school, whilst positively affirming the professional role of the teachers

Context

The new [Educate Together Senior Cycle Ethical Education Curriculum](#) has recently been published and will be delivered in all Educate Together Second-level schools. The curriculum specification was designed alongside a [Teacher's guide](#) which contains lesson plans, background information on each of the strands and suggested readings and videos.
