Fund and accelerate school patronage transfers

Support and fund religious-run schools to transfer to multi-denominational patronage. Properly resource this important Government programme.

Prioritise parental choice in education

Uphold the Constitutional right of parents to choose the type of school their children attend - conduct a national survey on parental preferences as a priority.

Improve school infrastructure and reform planning

Reform planning processes to reduce the time schools spend in unsuitable temporary accommodation and to ensure adequate interim facilities.

Hold a Citizen's Assembly on the future of education in Ireland

This should lead to a comprehensive Government strategy on school patronage and inclusive education in Ireland.

Prioritise education funding

Bring Ireland's education spending in line with the OECD average of 4.5% of GDP, so that schools and management bodies are properly funded and resourced.
