



## **Global Citizenship Education Project Mid-term Review Consultancy**

Educate Together is delivering a three-year Global Citizenship Education (GCE) Activism Project for primary schools, designed to support educators and pupils to act as informed global citizens within their schools and local communities. The project is funded by Irish Aid.

Educate Together is seeking applications from qualified individuals to conduct a review of the monitoring and evaluation framework and processes that are currently being used. This will help us to understand what is going well and will inform us how to improve our practice for the remainder of the project.

### **Context**

GCE is central to both the national Primary Curriculum and the Learn Together Curriculum, taught in Educate Together schools. This Activism Project aims to support educators to strengthen GCE practice in their classrooms.

The project began in August 2025 and will run until July 2028. Key activities include:

- Training for school staff
- Coordinating a Community of Practice
- Conducting consultations with school leaders, teachers, and students
- Developing resources
- Collaborating with the wider Irish GCE ecosystem

### **Review Brief:**

- Review the project monitoring and evaluation (M&E) documentation and data capturing tools to assess their effectiveness.
- Conduct interviews with key stakeholders.
- Identify whether evaluation findings are informing project progress.
- Provide recommendations for strengthening the existing M&E framework.
- Provide recommendations for organisational M&E processes beyond this project.

The review is expected to be initiated in July 2026.

### **Person Specification**

The review will be carried out by an individual who meets the following criteria:

- Minimum of five years' experience in Monitoring and Evaluating projects.
- Strong understanding of GCE practice in Ireland.
- Knowledge of the Educate Together ethos and the National Primary Curriculum.

### **Terms**

The main work is expected to take place within two calendar months of the appointment of the successful candidate, with a final review after a period of 10 months from the delivery of the final document. The maximum fee payable for this review is €2,000, inclusive of all costs associated with the consultancy.
